Park and Trail Master Plan: Empire's Park and Rec Commission and Planning Commission recommended approval to the Town Board for the Park and Trail Master Plan that they have been working on along with our Township Planner. Empire received a Dakota County Community Development Block Grant to create a Parks and Trails Master Plan. The proposed Master Plan is intended to include detailed summaries of existing park facilities, estimates of future park land and facilities needs and estimates of the costs of future park acquisitions and improvements.
