

**ORDINANCE NO. 240-B**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 240-A  
AND REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON  
TOWNSHIP ROADS AND PUBLIC PROPERTY ANNUALLY  
FROM NOVEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup> THROUGH APRIL 15<sup>TH</sup>**

The Board of Supervisors of Empire Township, Dakota County, Minnesota, ordains as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to park or leave a vehicle unattended for more than five (5) minutes, except for emergency, on any public street, public parking lot or other public property during the hours of 2:00 a.m. through 6:00 a.m. daily from November 1<sup>st</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup> annually.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and fined according to the maximum allowed by Minnesota State Statutes or according to a fee schedule adopted by the Town Board. Each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 240-B repeals Ordinance No. 240-A and shall be in full force and in effect from and after its passage and publication according to law. Adopted this 24<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2015.
