

ORDINANCE NO. 250-A

AN ORDINANCE BANNING LATE NIGHT PARKING.

The Town Board of the Township of Empire, County of Dakota, State of Minnesota, ordains as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner or driver of a motor vehicle to stop, stand or park a vehicle on any public street or public roadway within the Township for a period of longer than five (5) minutes during the hours of 3:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. daily except (a) when a person is rendering emergency medical assistance, or (b) when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or (c) when in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control device on any public street or public roadway, or (d) in areas of construction where off- street parking is not available and prior written notice is given to the Township explaining the need for overnight on-street parking.

Section 2. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and fined according to the maximum allowed by Minnesota State Statutes or according to a fee schedule adopted by the Town Board. Each day a that violation continues shall constitute a separate offense and fine.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 250-A repeals Ordinance No. 250 and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law. Adopted this 23rd day of July, 2013.
